Getting on the Balcony

by Rev. Benjamin Broadbent, Senior Minister

Imagine you're on a dancefloor in a crowd of people. Some around you are dancing in couples, others alone, and still others in groups. You notice

their clothes and hairstyles and ages (you're guessing) and their dance moves. After a while, you see a balcony overlooking the event and you decide to go up. From the balcony, you see things you hadn't noticed before – people coming in and going out, others sitting along the edges, and the way the whole group moves as a single organism to sound of the music.

Richard Heifetz says that leaders need to "Get on the Balcony" to see an organization as a whole and provide leadership from that perspective. Last month, our congregation adopted a major revision of our church's Bylaws, enabling a new governance structure which now includes a Leadership Council. An important role of the eight council members is to "get on the balcony" to get a wider perspective as leaders of our congregation. This won't happen in one meeting, or even a few meetings. Leadership is a continuous process of noticing and asking and listening and experimenting.

So pray for the newly elected members of our Leadership Council as begin their work. And remember that, as members of the church and followers of Jesus, all of us are ministers, that is, servant-leaders of our congregation and the wider world.

Our Whole Lives/Sexuality & Our Faith Continues!

What is OWL?

Our Whole Lives/Sexuality & Our Faith (OWL) is a comprehensive sexuality program created by our denomination, the UCC, alongside the Unitarians. Our religious heritages compel us to create safe settings where people can come to understand and respond to their experiences as sexual beings. OWL is a series of sexuality education curricula for six age groups: grades K-1, 4-6, 7-9, 10-12, young adult, and adult. The program provides an opportunity for children, youth, and adults to learn about sexuality in the affirming and supportive setting of our church. Grounded in a holistic view of sexuality, it provides not only facts about anatomy and human development, but also supports participants in clarifying values, integrating sexual and spiritual understandings, building interpersonal skills, and understanding the spiritual, emotional, social, and political aspects of sexuality.

Why is our church hosting an OWL Training?

Our church is gearing up to be a host site for training leaders in OWL this July. Both UCC and UUA (Unitarian) churches will be sending leaders to be trained at the Community Church. We (the Community Church OWL Team, a sub-group of the Children's Faith Formation Team) have hired two high-quality trainers, who will lead a weekendlong intensive in OWL. What this means is that our church is providing space, hospitality, and training for OWL leaders to go back to their home churches and lead OWL programs for grades 7-9 & 10-12 in the upcoming year. There are already host families from our church opening their homes to people attending our training, and the OWL Team is working hard to register and prepare for the training. Hosting an OWL Training really puts us on the map as a church that supports holistic sexuality education! Hurrah!



Safe Parking Volunteers Needed

Homelessness is an ongoing problem in our county and has been made worse by the fires of last year.

The Community Church, with help from Catholic Charities in Santa Rosa, will be restarting our Safe Parking program. Safe Parking will allow people that have no other place to sleep, other than in their car, to stay the night in a safe environment on our church property. The program will allow up to 5 vehicles to park from 8:00pm to 8:00am. Many participating in this program are families with jobs and children attending school. All participants will be screened by Catholic Charities and must participate in Catholic Charities' intake program to avail themselves to services that will hopefully find them a home.

Safe Parking at our church will only work if we have Site Volunteers. Site Volunteers will be needed to welcome participants, show them where to park, provide them with a Safe Parking Dashboard Placard and show them how to get access to bathrooms. Site Volunteers would also be asked to drive through the lot once a night to see that only vehicles registered in the program are on the premises.

Our goal is to have enough volunteers so no single volunteer would be needed more than one night a week.
