- To support, direct, and partner with the church staff team.
- To be am bassadors to the community on behalf of the Community Church.

#### Norms for the Council:

- 1. Keep the mission of the Council in mind. No personal agendas.
- 2. Follow the Bylaws.
- 3. Attend meetings, arrive on time, and stop on time. Focus on agenda items and honor people's time.
- 4. Come prepared. Do your homework and follow through. (Meeting Summary)
- 5. Know the purpose of agenda items and stay focused.
- 6. Share the air: Avoid interrupting, digressing, and repeating yourself.
- 7. Respect the expertise, time, and

- contribution-style of others.
- 8. Participate fully. Listen carefully and ask good questions.
- 9. Be honest. Agree to share disagreements, and agree to disagree amicably. Keep disagreements within the Council.
- 10. Maintain confidentiality.
- 11. Use fist to five for consensus for non voting items
- 12. Enjoy the work and enjoy each other.
